#### 1. PARTIES:

Applicant is Amoco Production Company, Security Life Building, Denver, Colorado 80202. The party to be pooled is Crown Central Petroleum Corp., Suite 1002, Wilco Bldg., Midland, Texas 79701

#### 2. ALLEGATION OF FACTS:

By Order R-13 dated March 15, 1950, this Commission created the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, and last extended by Order R-5129 dated January 1, 1976. In accordance with said orders the following 160-acre gas spacing units in T31N, R10W have been created:

Amoco proposes to drill a well on each of the above described units to test the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs common source of supply. The estimated cost of each of said wells will be \$82,500 for a producing well or \$42,240 should such well be a dry hole.

Amoco has reached a voluntary agreement for the drilling of each of said wells with all parties except Crown Central Petroleum Corp.

#### 3. LEGAL AUTHORITY:

New Mexico Conservation Act, Sec. 65-3-14.

#### 4. RELIEF SOUGHT:

Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon hearing, this Commission issue an order which includes the following provisions:

(a) That all outstanding interests be pooled in the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool underlying the following four - 160-acre gas spacing units in T31N, R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico:

Sammons Gas Com G	NE/4 of Section 6
McEwen Gas Com B	NW/4 of Section 5
Sammons Gas Com H	SE/4 of Section 6
Usselman Gas Com C	NW/4 of Section 4

- (b) That Amoco Production Company be named as operator of each of said units.
- (c) That the estimated cost of the producing well be fixed at \$82,500 and that the dry hole cost be fixed at \$42,240, and, further, that the combined fixed rates while drilling, completing and producing be fixed.
- (d) That the risk factor for the nonconsenting owners' penalty be fixed at a rate not to exceed 200%.
