NOW, on this 8th day of June, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Dome Petroleum Corporation, is the owner of the Santa Fe and Pacific Railroad Well No. 1, located in Unit G of Section 20, Township 21 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That said well was completed as an oil well capable of producing from the Entrada formation on February 12, 1977, through perforations from 5604 feet to 5612 feet.
