- Q Mr. Pickering, by whom are you employed and in what position?
- A. I'm employed by HNG Oil Company as Administrative
 Supervisor in charge of filing all Commission forms and Federal
 forms.
 - Q Have you ever testified before the Commission and had

- A. No.
- Q. Would you please briefly summarize for the Examiner your education and work experience?
- A. I hold a BBA degree from the University of Texas. I worked for the Texas Railroad Commission for four years as a proration analyst and for the last two years I have worked for HNG Oil Company.
- 0. Mr. Pickering, are you familiar with the application of HNG in this case?
 - A Yes, I am.
- Q Are you familiar with the El Paso Federal 29 Well No. and also the circumstances surrounding this application?
 - A. Yes, I am.
 - Q What does HNG seek with its application?
- A. To have an unorthodox location approved and not to be required to move it back to the original location.

MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, are the witness' qualifications acceptable?

MR. STAMETS: Yes, they are.

- Q (Mr. Carr continuing.) Would you please refer to what has been marked as Applicant's Exhibit Number One and explain to the Examiner what it reflects?
- A. This is a letter from John West Engineering Company, signed by Mr. John West, whereby he states that in error by

not having good reference points the well was mis-staked, I guess would be the term. Instead of being six sixty from the west line and nineteen eighty from the north line, it was his error by taking a mis-reference point and it turned out to be too close to the quarter-quarter section line, however, but still within the boundaries, you know, of the half section. The actual location turned out to be nine hundred and four feet from the west line and two thousand four hundred and twenty-seven feet from the north line. This resulted in the unorthodox location.

0 Mr. Pickering, relying on this incorrect survey has HNG incurred any costs?

A. Yes, this is a Federal land and we have made an archeological study and all of the requirements from the USGS and the Bureau of Land Management. We have also spent approximately, a little over twenty thousand dollars in building our drilling pad.

- Q Has this unorthodox location been approved by the USGS?
 - A. Yes, it has.
 - Q From what formation do you plan to produce this well?
- A From the Morrow formation.
 - 0 How deep do you intend to drill?
 - A Approximately twelve thousand feet.
 - Q Will you please refer to what has been marked as

Exhibit Two and summarize for the Examiner what it shows?

A. This first exhibit here shows the proposed location, which is where the well is staked and the drill pad is constructed now. The yellow area is the HNG leases. The section in question is a farmout from El Paso Natural Gas and we plan to dedicate, of course, the west half of Section 29 to the well.

The nearest Morrow production is a well owned and operated by HNG Oil Company in Section 25 and that is the nearest Morrow production to this location.

- Q Has El Paso farmed out all of Section 29 to you?
- A Yes, sir.
- Q And you have indicated that this is a Federal lease?
- A. Right.
- Q Have you notified offsetting owners of your unorthodox location?
- A. Yes. Of course, El Paso and ourselves are the offsetting operators to this section.
- Q. Mr. Pickering, in moving from a standard location to the proposed location will you be closer to any offset owners than if you were drilling at other standard locations within the west half of Section 29?
 - A. No, we would not.
- Q In your opinion would the granting of this application be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste?

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on May 25, 1977, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 8th day of June, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, HNG Oil Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for its El Paso Federal 29 Well No. 1 to be located 2427 feet from the North line and 904 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, to test the Morrow formation, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the W/2 of said Section 29 is to be dedicated to the well.
- (4) That said unorthodox location resulted from an error in surveying.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.
- (6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

share of the gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That an unorthodox gas well location for the Morrow formation is hereby approved for the HNG Oil Company El Paso Federal 29 Well No. 1 to be located at a point 2427 feet from the North line and 904 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (2) That the W/2 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
