It is planned to implement a 40-acre five-spot flood pattern. This pattern will be developed by drilling 53 injection wells and converting 1 currently producing well to water injection. Water injection will be into the Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres formation at a depth of 3860' to 4860'. Injection will be down internally plastic-coated tubing with a packer set above the injection interval. Initial injection will be 900 barrels of water per day per well. Injection pressure will be maintained below fracture pressure. Injection water will be made up of formation water produced in the Central Vacuum Unit and fresh water from Texaco Inc. and Mobil Oil Co. water rights through supply wells in the Ogallala formation.

Attached is a plat of the Proposed Central Vacuum Unit project area showing current lease operators, a plat showing proposed well numbers, a diagrammatic sketch of a typical injection well, a type log showing proposed unitization interval, a structure map contoured on top of San Andres pay, and a list of offset operators. Detailed information and exhibits supporting this application will be presented at the hearing.






