#### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on June 8, 1977, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 21st day of June, 1977, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Hudson & Hudson, seeks approval for the unorthodox locations of 14 oil wells to be drilled at the following locations in the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico:

- (5) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

- Q Would you please state your name, by whom you're employed and in what capacity?
- A. Ralph Gray, I'm employed by William A. and Edward R. Hudson in the capacity of consulting engineer.
- @ Mr. Gray, have you previously testified before the Commission and had your qualifications as an expert petroleum engineer accepted and made a matter of record?
  - A Yes, sir.
- Q Have you made a study of and are you familiar with the facts surrounding this particular application?

#### A. Yes.

MR. KELLAHIN: If the Examiner please, are the witness' qualifications acceptable?

MR. NUTTER: Yes, they are.

Q (Mr. Kellahin continuing.) Would you please refer, Mr. Gray, to what has been marked as Exhibit Number One, identify it, and explain briefly what you're seeking to accomplish?

A. Exhibit Number One is a ownership map of this area and this shows all of the wells and the proposed unor-thodox locations are indicated on the map by the red circles.

Directly offsetting the Puckett A and B leases to the east is the Continental MCA unit, and although the map shows some individual ownerships, all of this area is not unitized and is operated by Continental Oil Company.

As the map indicates, Continental has in-fill drilled most of this unit. Then directly north of the proposed unorthodox locations in Section 24 is the Hudson-Puckett A lease. This lease also has been developed with in-fill drilling, so the locations as proposed are merely a centinuation of the pattern that exists in the area at this time.

Do you have the previous Commission case numbers
 and order numbers with regards to approval of the Puckett A
 lease in Section 24?

A Yes. The original case was Number 2536 and the

order number was R-2239, and this authorized the waterflood project on the Puckett A lease. Then, this was later expanded and this was heard under Case Number 3566 and the authorization was by Order Number R-3230.

- Q Did you testify in those cases, Mr. Gray?
- A. Yes,
- Q On behalf of Hudson & Hudson?
- A. Yes.

MR. KELLAHIN: If the Examiner please, we move to incorporate the records in the previous two cases with the case here.

MR. NUTTER: Case records in Case Number 2536 and 3566 will be incorporated in the record of Case Number 5952.

Q (Mr. Kellahin continuing.) Would you refer to Exhibit Number Two and identify that?

A. Exhibit Number Two is a more detailed map of this area and it's intended to show these unorthodox locations in a little bit better manner. These, essentially, are drilled twenty-five feet out of the corners of the regular 40-acre subdivisions, except that the locations along the east line of the section are spaced three hundred and thirty feet from the lease line.

- Q What will be the spacing of the wells off of the north line?
  - A. These will be twenty-five feet from that north


