1 MR. NUTTER: We will call next Case Number 5971.
 2 Case Number 5971 is in the matter of the hearing
 3 called by the Oil Conservation Commission on its own motion to
 4 permit John J. Moya, Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York
 5 and all other interested parties to appear and show cause why
 6 two certain wells in Sections 4 and 18 of Township 30 North,
 7 Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, should not be
 8 plugged and abandoned in accordance with a Commission-approved
 9 plugging program.

10 Call for appearances in this case.

11 MS. TESCHENDORF: Lynn Teschendorf appearing on
 12 behalf of the Commission. I have one witness to be sworn.

13 MR. NUTTER: Any other appearances in Case 5971?

14 (THEREUPON, the witness was duly sworn.

16 A. R. KENDRICK

17 called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, was examined
 18 and testified as follows:

19
 20 DIRECT EXAMINATION

21 BY MS. TESCHENDORF:

22 Q State your name and position, please?

23 A A. R. Kendrick, District Supervisor at Aztec for
 24 the Oil Conservation Commission.

25 Q Are you familiar with Case 5971?

1 A. Yes.

2 Q Is supervision of the operations of the wells
3 involved in this case part of your duties?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q Do you have the Commission's records of these wells
6 in your possession?

7 A. I do.

8 Q Would you please give a brief history of the wells
9 in this case?

10 A. The Moya Goode Well, the C-101 was approved on
11 July the first, 1953 and according to the Form C-105 the well
12 was spudded on June 3rd, 1953 and completed on August 22nd,
13 1953. It was reworked into a producible well on August 23rd,
14 1954 in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool. It first delivered
15 in the pipeline on February 9th, 1955.

16 I have an Exhibit One that shows the Moya Goode Well
17 identified by a line marked in red. Exhibit One consists of
18 four pages, all from the New Mexico Engineering Committee
19 reports for the years 1967, 1968, 1969 and 1976. The years
20 are identified at the bottom of each page.

21 According to the first page you will notice that
22 the Moya Goode Well produced eight hundred and forty-nine MCF
23 in 1967 and on the second page it identifies the well as
24 having produced one MCF in 1968 and twenty-five MCF in 1969
25 and according to the 1976 report it has not produced since

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1 1969.

2 The Moya Hubbard Well, the C-101 was approved on
3 October 23rd, 1953 and from the C-105 in the well file it was
4 spudded on October 21st, 1953, it was completed January 9th,
5 1954, it was recompleted on August 8th, 1954 as a producible
6 well in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool. It first delivered
7 on January 21st, 1955 into the pipeline.

8 On Exhibit One the production from the Moya Hubbard
9 Wells is identified by the lines marked in blue. It produced
10 ten thousand five hundred and forty-three MCF during 1967,
11 nine thousand three hundred and eighty-eight MCF during 1968,
12 one thousand two hundred and thirty-three MCF during 1969 and
13 has not produced since 1969.

14 Q Do you have any recommendations regarding these
15 wells?

16 A Yes, I recommend that these wells either be put to
17 a useful purpose as producible wells or properly plugged and
18 abandoned.

19 Q How much time should the operator have to complete
20 these wells?

21 A About sixtydays I think would be sufficient.

22 Q Do you have a specific date in mind?

23 A Yes, I believe these wells can have the paperwork
24 and field work done by September 16th, 1977.

25 Q In your opinion could failure to plug these wells

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1 cause waste?

2 A. Yes, there is a possibility of casing failure in each
 3 of these wells thereby either waterflooding the producible
 4 formation or by losing the gas into the water sand.

5 Q. Do you have a recommendation regarding a plugging
 6 program for these wells?

7 A. Yes, but I think our recommendation for the plugging
 8 program should be delayed until we learn what the exact
 9 downhole situation is and work out a plugging program for each
 10 hole as the plugging progresses.

11 Q. Do you have anything further in this case?

12 A. No.

13 Q. Was your Exhibit One prepared by you or under your
 14 supervision?

15 A. Yes.

16 MS. TESCHENDORF: I offer Exhibit One in evidence.

17 MR. NUTTER: Exhibit One of Case 5971 will be
 18 admitted into evidence.

19 (THEREUPON, OCC Exhibit One was admitted
 20 into evidence.)

21

22 CROSS EXAMINATION

23 BY MR. NUTTER:

24 Q. Mr. Kendrick, the last production from each of the
 25 wells was in 1969, is that correct?

1 A. Yes.

2 Q. Why did the wells quit producing, in your opinion?

3 A. I think there are two problems involved, one is the
4 lack of ownership of sufficient interest in the well for the
5 operator to properly maintain them. I think he sold so much
6 interest in the wells that his monetary return is too low for
7 him to bother to look after the wells and his lack of interest
8 in treating his partners fairly in looking after their interest
9 after he sold them an interest in the well.

10 Q. Is this operator currently operating any wells that
11 are producing in the San Juan Basin?

12 A. No.

13 Q. He formerly did produce other wells in addition to
14 these two, did he not?

15 A. These wells and two others, yes. When the production
16 dropped off severely he failed to maintain an interest in the
17 wells and some of his partners would take their vacation and
18 come by and catch up the paperwork so the wells could be
19 produced for a few more months in each year and their interest
20 got so low that they couldn't afford to commute from Chicago
21 or New York to maintain their income.

22 Q. In effect does it appear that he has resigned from
23 these wells?

24 A. We did receive a letter from him where he resigned
25 from everything from these wells except the royalty.

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1 MR. NUTTER: Are there any other questions of this
2 witness? Mr. Ramey?

4 CROSS EXAMINATION

5 BY MR. RAMEY:

6 Q Mr. Kendrick, if Mr. Moya or the Fidelity & Casualty
7 Company would not plug the wells and the Commission had to plug
8 them under our new plugging law would it be possible to work up
9 a plugging program to send to various plugging operators on a
10 bid basis?

11 A Yes, sir.

12 MR. RAMEY: Thank you.

13 MR. NUTTER: Are there any further questions of this
14 witness? He may be excused.

15 (THEREUPON, the witness was excused.)

16 MR. NUTTER: Do you have anything further, Ms.
17 Teschendorf?

18 MS. TESCHENDORF: No, I don't.

19 MR. NUTTER: Does anyone have anything they wish to
20 offer in Case Number 5971? We will take the case under
21 advisement.

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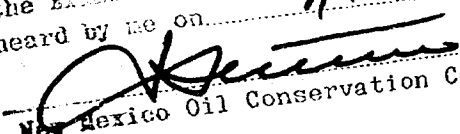

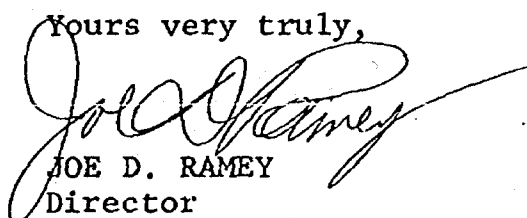

(1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the
subject matter thereof.

(2) That John J. Moya is the owner and operator of the
Hubbard Well No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 4 and the Goode
Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 18, both in Township 30
North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

(3) That Fidelity & Casualty Company of New York is the
surety on the Oil Conservation Commission plugging bond on which
John J. Moya is principal.

(4) That the purpose of said bond is to assure the state
that the subject wells will be properly plugged and abandoned
when not capable of commercial production.

(5) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative
rights said Hubbard Well No. 1 and Goode Well No. 1 should be
plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by
the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation
Commission on or before September 15, 1977, or the well should
be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.
