2. Applicant has recently drilled the following wells on said lease:

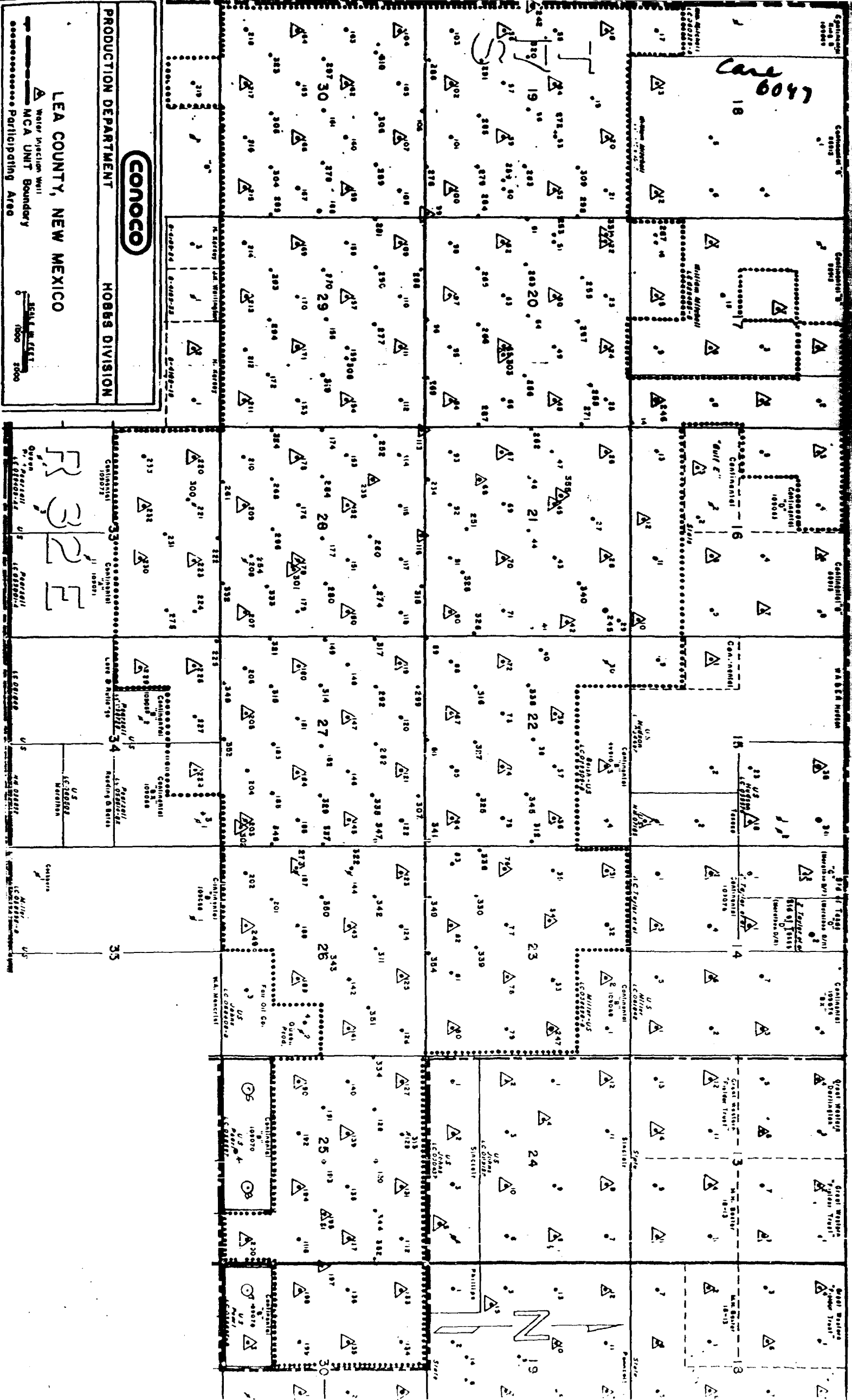
Pearl "B" No. 5	660' FSL & 760' FWL	Section 25, T-17-S, R-32-E
Pearl "B" No. 6	660' FSL & 1980' FEL	Section 25, T-17-S, R-32-E

3. Said wells are within the Maljamar Cooperative Agreement but are outside the MCA Unit Participating Area.
4. The waterflood project has been in operation within the MCA Unit Participating Area, and these wells have evidentially received stimulus from that waterflood project so that the wells are capable of producing oil at rates above the normal unit allowable.
5. Failure to produce said wells at capacity will result in loss of recoverable oil.
6. The granting of this application is in the interest of the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests this matter be set for hearing before the Commission's duly appointed examiner, and upon hearing an order be entered authorizing the capacity allowable as described above.
