Incorporated, advising them that our rules required that the casing be cemented, and that wells which were abandoned for a period of sixty days or more were to be considered as candidates for plugging and abandonment.

There was no response to my letter of March 21st and on August the 29th I sent a letter to the legal department here in Santa Fe, a copy to the operator, requesting that this case be docketed, and the only subsequent report to that I have received is one phone call; the gist which was that they had drilled the well and would like to make a commercial well out of it.

I was on the location yesterday and, apparently, nothing was done since our field man was out on September the 20th and took pictures of the location at that time and the photograph I got yesterday indicate that the junk being about the same place as it was on September the 20th.

- Q What was the date of that phone call, do you remember?
- A. The date prior to the docketed case, which would have been about two weeks ago yesterday.
 - Q. Is that all the records on the well?
 - A. Yes.
- 0. Is there a bond on this well running to the State of New Mexico?
 - A. I don't think there's a bond wherein the State of

New Mexico is the beneficiary; this is on a federal lease.

- 0. Do you have any other communications relative to the case that should be called to the Examiner's attention?
- A. I sent a letter on September the 30th advising the operator that the case had been continued at his request and that in the absence of further reports reaching my office by last Friday, testimony would be taken today.

It was received in their office in Albuquerque on October the 3rd, it says here, in Roswell.

- Q In your opinion would the failure to plug this well cause waste?
 - A. It could.
 - Q Would you elaborate on that, please?
- A. This well is offsetting another well which is producing. The well is producing with gas from the well to operate the pumping unit. Failure to produce this well in a business-like manner, cement the casing, can either allow water to penetrate the pay zone and flood out the producing interval, or to allow the gas and oil from the pay zone to penetrate into possible shallower water sands in the area.
- Q. Are you prepared to recommend a plugging program at this time or would you prefer to describe the program at the actual time of plugging?
- A. I'd prefer to work out the plugging program with the operator and the USGS, since this is on a federal lease.

Well, apparently I failed to send in a form here that should have been sent in after I talked with Mr. Kendrick which is a Sundry Notice and Report on Wells.

See, all this is new to me and I just kind of got caught up in this and trying to bog my way through the best way I can, but I think that well will make a producing well, and I'd like to try it. Mr. Hand has proposed to -- a procedure here to try and see if the well can be put back on production. Do you feel that this is a good procedure or not a good procedure and why?

MR. KENDRICK: If the casing is cemented and he is intending to acid-treat or fracture-treat the formation, this would be in the realm of normal operation, and there is a possibility of making a commercial, producable well out of this.

MR. STAMETS: How much cement would be required on this casing before this work should proceed?

MR. KENDRICK: We have to get some more records because we don't know what the hole size is outside the casing to calculate the fill-up.

MR. STAMETS: Normally what would you require, a couple hundred feet above the pay zone?

STAMETS: Mr. Hand, if you were given the period of time, say 120 days after the date of this hearing, in which to -- perhaps 90 days would be a better time -- in which to either put this well on production in accordance with Commission Rules and Regulations, and that would include cementing the casing, or plug the well, would that give you enough time to do one of these operations?

MR. HAND: I think it will, because Dowell, they said they'd only need a couple of days notice; just get my rig and the equipment. He's promised -- well, he promised me on the 4th and now he says the 17th.

MR. STAMETS: You do understand Mr. Kendrick feels that this casing must be cemented before --

MR. HAND: Before we treat it.

MR. STAMETS: Before you treat it, that's correct.

MR. HAND: Well, we could do that, yeah.

MR. KENDRICK: Maybe you'd better stay with 120 days, because his location out there, if there comes a good shower he's not going to get there the same day, or he's not going to get back.

MR. STAMETS: Okay.

days to either put the well to commercial production or to plug the hole.
