A P P L I C A T I O N

COME NOW, E. L. Latham, Jr., Roy G. Barton, Jr., and R. L. Foree, as provided by Section 65-3-10, et seq. New Mexico Statutes, 1953, as amended, and apply to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for an order requiring Phillips Petroleum Company to temporarily limit or shut in production from the LaRue and Muncy Nola Well #1 in Unit O of Section 8, Township 14 South, Range 28 East, Sams Ranch Grayburg Gas Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicants further request the Commission to initiate proration in the pool, recognizing correlative rights under Section 65-3-10, New Mexico Statutes, 1953, as amended, and request that said proration be retro-active to the commencement of production from said pool. Applicants further request that the Commission direct the gas purchaser in said pool to cease its discrimination in purchasing gas from said pool and to take ratably from said pool, under the provisions of Section 65-3-15, New Mexico Statutes, 1953, as amended, and directing that penalties be assessed against said purchaser upon failure to comply with said statutes under Section 65-3-19, New Mexico Statutes, 1953, as amended, and in support thereof Applicants would show:

1. Applicants are the owners of the lease rights to the W/2 of Section 9, above Township and Range, and have drilled their Amoco Federal No. 1 thereon in Unit M of said Section. Said well was completed on March 18, 1977, agreements were

reached with El Paso Natural Gas Company through its agent, Phillips Petroleum Company, gas purchaser in said field, to connect said well on May 6, 1977. The purchaser has failed to connect said well to the pipeline and to purchase Applicants' gas.

2. The well in Unit O of Section 8, above Township and Range, was connected by the purchaser in said field on June 11, 1977, and between said date and October 1 has produced approximately 200,000,000 cubic feet of gas.

3. Gas is being drained from Applicants' lease by said well in Section 8 without counter drainage as evidenced by a drop in bottom hole pressure of 65 lbs. in Applicants' well from completion to October 4, 1977, and during this time Applicants have produced no gas.

4. Purchaser has connected only one other well in the field and has produced from said well only approximately 7 million cubic feet of gas.

5. Eleven wells have been completed in the field which the purchaser has not connected.

6. Applicants' correlative rights have been violated by the purchaser in this pool in that purchaser is withdrawing gas in Section 8 and not in Section 9, denying Applicants the opportunity to produce their just and equitable share of the oil and gas in the pool in proportion that the gas under their property bears to the total gas in the pool.

7. Applicants have tendered to the purchaser their gas, but the purchaser has unreasonably discriminated in favor of the producers in Section 8 over Applicants in Section 9 in the quantity of gas purchased in said pool.

8. By purchasing gas from Section 8 and not from Section 9 and other sections, the purchaser has failed to take ratably from the common source of supply in the Sams Ranch Pool.

9. Unless said well in Unit O of Section 8 is shut in or limited in its production, Applicants will be denied their right to obtain their just and equitable share of the gas

underlying their land.

10. Unless said pool is prorated and the allowable production allocated upon a reasonable basis, recognizing correlative rights, Applicants will be denied their right to obtain their just and equitable share of the gas underlying their land.


11. Unless the Commission applies said proration to the pool retroactively, Applicants will be denied their right to obtain their just and equitable share of the gas underlying their land.

WHEREFORE, Applicants respectfully request that the Commission set this matter for hearing before the Commission's duly appointed examiner on October 26, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Commission enter its order granting the relief above prayed for and for further orders as may be proper in the premises.
