- Q. Would you please summarize the well history?
- A. Permit to drill this well was approved on October 3rd, 1941, and at that time it was filed as Frank B. Haddack. The well was spudded on 11/8/1941, and drilled to a total depth of four hundred and sixty-four feet. They set seven inch casing at four hundred and thirty-two feet with twenty-five sacks of cement.

The well was completed from open hole four hundred and thirty-two feet to four hundred and sixty-four feet.

It was completed on 12/29/41. The operator named on the well was changed to Randolph Johnson in 1950, and to J. C. Davis in 1951, Pat Evans in 1953, and to Rutter and Wilbanks Brothers effective 3/1/1960.

The well produced -- the last production reported was in May and June of 1963, and the well has been shut in since that time.

MR. NUTTER: What pool is this in, Mr. Gressett?

- A. This is in the Empire Yates Seven Rivers.
 - MR. NUTTER: How much has the well pumped?
- A. Cumulative to 1/1/64, is five thousand seven hundred and ninety-four barrels.
- Q. (Ms. Teschendorf continuing.) The last official form filed with the Commission was in 1963, is that correct?


