


DEAR MR. EXAMINER:

DURHAM, INC. IS THE LEASEHOLD OWNER UNDER THE CORRINE GRACE INDIAN HILLS COMM. No. 1, SECTION 8, T-21-S, R-24-E, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

IT IS OUR OPINION THAT, WITH THE BATA AVAILABLE TO US AT THE PRESENT TIME, THERE IS VERY LITTLE POTENTIAL FOR ECONOMIC RECOVERY OF HYDROCARBONS IN THE ABOVE MENTIONED WELL.

In a previous case (6389) before the Conhission held on November 21, 1978, Durham, Inc. requested a pool contraction and pool extension which covered Section 8, T-21-S, R-24-E, Eddy County, New Mexico. If the Commission grants our request, we intend to spud a well by March of 1979 at a legal location in the North 1/2 of Section 8. It is felt that data obtained from this well will be beneficial in determining the remaining potential of the Corrine Grace well.

Should the proposed well in the North 1/2 of Section 8 encounter a shallower pay or additional Morrow pay not tested in the Corrine Grace well, an attempt hay be made to establish production in the Corrine Grace well at a reasonable cost.
