ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on August 22, 1979, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 14th day of November, 1979, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the bremises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in McKinley County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Mesaverde formation, said pool to bear the designation of Star-Mesaverde Oil Pool. Said Star-Mesaverde Oil Pool was discovered by the WTR Oil Company State Well No. 1 located in Unit D of Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 6 West, NMPM. It was completed in the Mesaverde formation on April 26, 1974. The top of the perforations is at 2174 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Farmington formation, said pool to bear the designation of Bisti-Farmington Pool. Said Bisti-Farmington Pool was discovered by the Dome Petroleum Corporation Hanlad Federal Well No. 1 located in Unit F of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 12 West, NMPM. It was completed in the Farmington formation on September 10, 1977. The top of the perforations is at 660 feet.



MR. NUTTER: We'll call now Case Number 6639, which is in the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division on its own motion for an order creating and extending pools in McKinley, Rio Arriba, Sandoval, and San Juan Conties, New Mexico.
