Re: Chevron Jal Landfarm (Permit NM-02-0012), Lea County, New Mexico Minor Permit Modification Request

Mr. Jones:

On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), Arcadis U.S., Inc. (Arcadis) has prepared this Minor Permit Modification Request for the Jal Landfarm, a centralized surface waste management facility (NM-02-0012) located in Lea County, New Mexico (Site).

To date, the Site has been operating under the requirements of permit NM-02-0012 and 19.15.36 New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC; 02/14/2007, as amended through 06/30/2016), commonly referred to as "Part 36". In accordance with provision 19.15.36.8(D) NMAC, CEMC is submitting this Minor Permit Modification Request to request the following change to the landfarm operation requirements described in permit NM-02-0012: reduce the site inspection frequency from weekly to monthly.

As specified by permit NM-02-0012 Landfarm Operation condition 11, "landfarm inspection and maintenance must be conducted on a weekly basis or immediately following a consequential rainstorm or windstorm". CEMC requests to reduce site inspections from weekly to monthly. No earth-moving activities are occurring onsite on a weekly basis; the facility has not received any soil since 2007 and biweekly tilling was discontinued in December 2020. In addition, to ensure that no one trespasses onto the Site, there is fencing around the Site perimeter and a locked gate. Therefore, monthly site inspections should be adequate to ensure that the Site remains in good condition. CEMC will continue to inspect the landfarm following consequential rainstorms and will remove freestanding water as needed, as specified in provision 19.15.36.15.C(8) NMAC.

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed its review of Chevron Environmental Management Company's (CEMC) minor modification request, dated August 22, 2022, to the commercial surface waste management facility permit, NM2-012. CEMC has requested the following permit minor modification:

CEMC requests to modify Condition 11, under the heading Landfarm Operations, to reduce site
inspections from weekly to monthly. Condition 11 requires the following: Landfarm inspection
and maintenance must be conducted on a weekly basis or immediately following a
consequential rainstorm or windstorm.

OCD hereby grants CEMC approval of the minor modification request to permit NM2-012 with the following conditions:

- CEMC shall comply with all applicable requirements of the Oil and Gas Act (Chapter 70, Article 2 NMSA 1978), the existing permit NM1-012 as modified, the transitional provisions of 19.15.36.20 NMAC, and all conditions specified in this approval;
- 2. CEMC shall inspect the landfarm and berms monthly and after a major rainfall or windstorm, and maintain the berms in such a manner as to prevent erosion; and
- 3. CEMC shall obtain written approval from OCD prior to implementing any changes to this approval.

Please be advised that approval of this request does not relieve CEMC of liability should operations result in pollution of surface water, ground water or the environment.
