The operator may extend the allowed time on an annual basis thereafter with division approval if, 30 days prior to the registration expiration, the operator files a form C-147 with an attached summary showing all monthly inspections at the containment, including the monitoring of the leak detection system, showing the containment’s integrity has not been compromised.”*



Good morning Mr. Doerr.

The Oil Conservation Division has reviewed the registration/permit annual extension request received from [4323] CHEVRON USA INC on 04/02/2025, Application ID 448134, for 2RF-120 Hayhurst NM Section 2 Frac Pond and Recycle Facility ID [fAB1805848203]. The requested annual extension is approved with the following conditions of approval:

- 2RF-120 Hayhurst NM Section 2 Frac Pond and Recycle Facility ID [fAB1805848203] is approved for one (1) year of operation from the date of the previous registration/permit expiration date of March 22, 2025. The new registration/permit expiration date is March 22, 2026.
- [4323] CHEVRON USA INC will continue to operate, maintain, and close the 2RF-120 Hayhurst NM Section 2 Frac Pond and Recycle Facility ID [fAB1805848203] in compliance with 19.15.34 NMAC, to include but not limited to the performance of weekly inspections regardless of fluid levels in the containment; recording of detailed inspection reports; removal of debris, foreign objects and oil from the containment; and monthly reporting of recycling and reuse of produced water, drilling fluids, and liquid oil field waste via from C-148.
- [4323] CHEVRON USA INC will maintain a liquid level in the containment that is at least equal to the weight of the liner plus 20%. [4323] CHEVRON USA INC may maintain a higher liquid level if they choose.
- [4323] CHEVRON USA INC will comply with 19.15.29 NMAC Releases in the event of any release at 2RF-120 Hayhurst NM Section 2 Frac Pond and Recycle Facility ID [fAB1805848203]. [4323] CHEVRON USA INC will comply with all other OCD rules.
- If [4323] CHEVRON USA INC wishes to extend the registration/permit past March 22, 2026, a registration/permit extension request must be submitted to OCD. Extension requests are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and evaluated on their merit. Extensions are considered for a maximum length of one year. Additional requests must be submitted through OCD Online on Form C-147 as an extension request and should include a formal extension request letter, a summary of the prior registration/permit period inspection reports, and the copies of the detailed inspection records for the prior permit period. The extension request should be submitted no later than February 22, 2026.
