ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on November 20, 2024, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing and Technical Examiners, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC submitted an application (“Application”) to compulsory pool the uncommitted oil and gas interests within the spacing unit (“Unit”) described in Exhibit A. Operator seeks to be designated the operator of the Unit.
2. Coterra Energy Operating Company (“Operator”) acquired Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC’s interests within the Unit on or around January, 2025, and assumed Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC’s role in this case.
3. Operator will dedicate the well(s) described in Exhibit A (“Well(s)”) to the Unit.
4. Operator proposes the supervision and risk charges for the Well(s) described in Exhibit A.
5. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice was given.
6. Two sets of compulsory pooling applications were submitted by two different applicants:
 - a. MRC Permian Company submitted compulsory pooling applications proposing the following units:
 - i. In Case No. 24778; the Bone Spring Formation underlying Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, and the E/2 W/2 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - ii. In Case No. 24779; the Bone Spring Formation underlying the E/2 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - iii. In Case No. 24780; the Bone Spring Formation underlying Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.

- iv. In Case No. 24781; the Bone Spring Formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - v. In Case No. 24782; the Bone Spring Formation underlying the W/2 E/2 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - vi. In Case No. 24783; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - vii. In Case No. 24784; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - viii. In Case No. 24785; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the W/2 E/2 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - ix. In Case No. 24786; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the E/2 E/2 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
- b. Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC, now acquired by Operator, submitted compulsory pooling applications proposing the following units:
- i. In Case No. 24457; the Bone Spring Formation underlying Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 of Sections 18, 19, and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - ii. In Case No. 24459; the Bone Spring Formation underlying the E/2 of Sections 18, 19, and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - iii. In Case No. 24479; the Bone Spring Formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Sections 18, 19, and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - iv. In Case No. 24898; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the W/2 E/2 of Sections 19 and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - v. In Case No. 24899; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 of Sections 19 and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - vi. In Case No. 24900; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Sections 19 and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
 - vii. In Case No. 24901; the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the E/2 E/2 of Sections 19 and 30, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M.
7. MRC Permian Company requested that its cases be dismissed, and OCD dismissed them on April 29, 2026
8. Operator requested that 3 of its cases be dismissed, Case No. 24457, 24459, and 24479. OCD dismissed them on May 5, 2026.
9. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner on the date specified above, during which a contested hearing occurred involving all the cases included in Paragraph 6.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

10. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
11. Operator is the owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit.
12. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
13. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.
14. Operator has the right to drill the Well(s) to a common source of supply at the depth(s) and location(s) in the Unit described in Exhibit A.
15. The Unit contains separately owned uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals.
16. Some of the owners of the uncommitted interests have not agreed to commit their interests to the Unit.
17. The pooling of uncommitted interests in the Unit will prevent waste and protect correlative rights, including the drilling of unnecessary wells.
18. This Order affords to the owner of an uncommitted interest the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the oil or gas in the pool.

ORDER

19. The uncommitted interests in the Unit are pooled as set forth in Exhibit A.
20. The Unit shall be dedicated to the Well(s) set forth in Exhibit A.
21. Operator is designated as operator of the Unit and the Well(s).
22. If the location of a well will be unorthodox under the spacing rules in effect at the time of completion, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard location in accordance with 19.15.16.15(C) NMAC.
23. If the Unit is a non-standard horizontal spacing unit which has not been approved under this Order, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard horizontal spacing unit in accordance with 19.15.16.15(B)(5) NMAC.
24. Operator shall commence drilling the Well(s) within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well.

25. This Order shall terminate automatically if the Operator fails to comply with the preceding paragraph unless the Operator requests an extension by notifying the OCD and all parties that required notice of the original compulsory pooling application in accordance with 19.15.4.12.B and 19.15.4.12.C NMAC. Upon no objection after twenty (20) days the extension is automatically granted up to one year. If a protest is received the extension is not granted and the Operator must set the case for a hearing.
26. Operator may propose reasonable deviations from the development plan via notice to the OCD and all parties that required notice of the original compulsory pooling application in accordance with 19.15.4.12.B and 19.15.4.12.C NMAC. Upon no objection after twenty (20) days the deviation is automatically granted. If a protest is received the deviation is not granted and the Operator must set the case for a hearing.
27. The infill well requirements in 19.15.13.9 NMAC through 19.15.13.12 NMAC shall be applicable.
28. Operator shall submit each owner of an uncommitted working interest in the pool (“Pooled Working Interest”) an itemized schedule of estimated costs to drill, complete, and equip the well (“Estimated Well Costs”).
29. No later than thirty (30) days after Operator submits the Estimated Well Costs, the owner of a Pooled Working Interest shall elect whether to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or its share of the actual costs to drill, complete and equip the well (“Actual Well Costs”) out of production from the well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who elects to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall render payment to Operator no later than thirty (30) days after the expiration of the election period, and shall be liable for operating costs, but not risk charges, for the well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who fails to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or who elects to pay its share of the Actual Well Costs out of production from the well shall be considered to be a “Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest.”
30. No later than one hundred eighty (180) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the Actual Well Costs. The Actual Well Costs shall be considered to be the Reasonable Well Costs unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Reasonable Well Costs after public notice and hearing.
31. No later than sixty (60) days after the expiration of the period to file a written objection to the Actual Well Costs or OCD’s order determining the Reasonable Well Costs, whichever is later, each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall

pay to Operator its share of the Reasonable Well Costs that exceed the Estimated Well Costs, or Operator shall pay to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs its share of the Estimated Well Costs that exceed the Reasonable Well Costs.

32. The reasonable charges for supervision to drill and produce a well ("Supervision Charges") shall not exceed the rates specified in Exhibit A, provided however that the rates shall be adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form entitled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."
33. No later than within ninety (90) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the reasonable charges for operating and maintaining the well ("Operating Charges"), provided however that Operating Charges shall not include the Reasonable Well Costs or Supervision Charges. The Operating Charges shall be considered final unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Operating Charges after public notice and hearing.
34. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs: (a) the proportionate share of the Supervision Charges; and (b) the proportionate share of the Operating Charges.
35. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest: (a) the proportionate share of the Reasonable Well Costs; (b) the proportionate share of the Supervision and Operating Charges; and (c) the percentage of the Reasonable Well Costs specified as the charge for risk described in Exhibit A.
36. Operator shall distribute a proportionate share of the costs and charges withheld pursuant to the preceding paragraph to each Pooled Working Interest that paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs.
37. Each year on the anniversary of this Order, and no later than ninety (90) days after each payout, Operator shall provide to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest a schedule of the revenue attributable to a well and the Supervision and Operating Costs charged against that revenue.
38. Any cost or charge that is paid out of production shall be withheld only from the share due to an owner of a Pooled Working Interest. No cost or charge shall be withheld from the share

due to an owner of a royalty interests. For the purpose of this Order, an unleased mineral interest shall consist of a seven-eighths (7/8) working interest and a one-eighth (1/8) royalty interest.

39. Except as provided above, Operator shall hold the revenue attributable to a well that is not disbursed for any reason for the account of the person(s) entitled to the revenue as provided in the Oil and Gas Proceeds Payment Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 70-10-1 et seq., and relinquish such revenue as provided in the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 7-8A-1 et seq.
40. The Unit shall terminate if (a) the owners of all Pooled Working Interests reach a voluntary agreement; or (b) the well(s) drilled on the Unit are plugged and abandoned in accordance with the applicable rules. Operator shall inform OCD no later than thirty (30) days after such occurrence.
41. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.
