ORDER NO. AG-N-36

GAS PRORATION ORDER FOR PERIOD APRIL 1, 1974  
THROUGH MARCH 31, 1975

This cause came on for public hearing by the Commission's Examiner, Richard L. Stamets, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on February 13, 1974, at 9 a.m., pursuant to legal notice, for the purpose of setting the allowable production of gas from the following five gas pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba, and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, for the one-year period, April 1, 1974, through March 31, 1975.

Basin-Dakota, Blanco-Mesaverde, Blanco-Pictured Cliffs, South, Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs, and Devils Fork-Gallup.

NOW, on this 21st day of February, 1974, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the nominations of purchasers, the capacity of producing wells, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That the total nomination of purchasers of gas produced from the above-listed five gas pools for the period April 1, 1974, through March 31, 1975, is 491,097,000 Mcf. The individual pool nominations are as follows:

Basin-Dakota	197,851,100 Mcf
Blanco-Mesaverde	243,611,000 Mcf
Blanco-Pictured Cliffs, South	39,201,800 Mcf
Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs	10,110,900 Mcf
Devils Fork-Gallup	322,200 Mcf

(2) That the potential producing capacity of all gas wells in the five gas pools listed above is in excess of the nominations of purchasers of gas, and in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, the production of gas from the above-listed five gas pools should be limited, allocated, and distributed during the one-year proration period commencing April 1, 1974.

(3) That all the producing gas wells, together with the expected completed or recompleted wells in the five gas pools listed above, can produce a total of 491,097,000 Mcf without causing waste within the one-year proration period commencing April 1, 1974, and an allocation based upon such production would be reasonable and would protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That for the one-year proration period commencing April 1, 1974, the total allowable production to be assigned the five allocated gas pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba, and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, is as follows:

Basin-Dakota	197,851,100 Mcf
Blanco-Mesaverde	243,611,000 Mcf
Blanco-Pictured Cliffs, South	39,201,800 Mcf
Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs	10,110,900 Mcf
Devils Fork-Gallup	322,200 Mcf

(2) That the allocation hereby set for said one-year proration period in the five allocated pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba, and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, shall be in accordance with the Commission Rules, Regulations, and Orders.

(3) That the total allowable production for each pool as set forth shall be allocated on a monthly basis and shall be adjusted monthly to meet changes in market conditions as reflected by purchasers' supplemental nominations and actual gas production, in accordance with the Commission Rules, Regulations, and Orders.


The foregoing order shall remain effective until further order of the Commission.
