ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 15, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17th day of February, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation South Denton-Wolfcamp Pool. Said South Denton-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., New Mexico "M" Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 of Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 37 East, NMPM. It was completed November 21, 1960. The top of perforations is at 9488 feet.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Paddock formation, said pool to bear the designation Empire-Paddock Pool. Said Empire-Paddock Pool was discovered by Pan American Petroleum Corporation, USA J. H. Harbold Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 34, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. It was completed November 22, 1960. The top of perforations is at 3075 feet.

(4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation East Gladiola-Devonian Pool. Said East Gladiola-Devonian Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, East Gladiola Unit Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 11 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed November 17, 1960. The top of perforations is at 12,081 feet.

(5) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation Hondo-San Andres Pool. Said Hondo-San Andres Pool was discovered by M. R. Voltz, Kenneth V. Barbee Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 9, Township 11 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. It was completed October 20, 1960. The top of perforations is at 892 feet.

(6) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation Loco Hills-Wolfcamp Pool. Said Loco Hills-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by John H. Trigg, Federal Sivley Wright Well No. 1-20, located in the NW/4 of Section 20, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. It was completed October 19, 1960. The top of perforations is at 8685 feet.

(7) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Bone Springs formation, said pool to bear the designation Lusk-Bone Springs Pool. Said Lusk-Bone Springs Pool was discovered by El Paso Natural Gas Company, Lusk Deep Unit Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed October 26, 1960. The top of perforations is at 8759 feet.

(8) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation Remuda-Wolfcamp Pool. Said Remuda-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Texaco Inc., Remuda Basin Unit Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. It was completed December 15, 1960. The top of perforations is at 11,168 feet.

(9) That there is need for certain extensions to the Atoka-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and the Red Hills-Yates Pool, both in Eddy County, New Mexico; to the Anderson Ranch-Wolfcamp Pool, the Blinebry Oil Pool, the Corbin-Abo Pool, the Eumont Gas Pool, the North Mescalero-Wolfcamp Pool, the Paduca-Delaware Pool, the Pearl-Queen Pool, the San Simon Pool, and the West Tonto Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico; and to the Bluit-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

Further, that the proposed extensions to the Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool and the North Mason-Delaware Pool, both in Lea County, New Mexico, should be dismissed pending further study.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Wolfcamp production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the South Denton-Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 36: SW/4

(b) That a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Paddock production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Empire-Paddock Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 27 EAST, NMPM
Section 34: SE/4

(c) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Devonian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the East Gladiola-Devonian Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

Section 34: SW/4

(d) That a new pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for San Andres production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Hondo-San Andres Pool, consisting of the following-described area:
