ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 25, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Nutter, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 3rd day of November, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Leonard Oil Company, is the owner and operator of the Ginsberg-Federal Well No. 11, located in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 25 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant proposes to complete the said Ginsberg-Federal Well No. 11 as a triple completion (conventional) in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Justis Blinebry Pool through a string of 2 1/16-inch tubing and from an undesignated Tubb pool and the Justis Fusselman Pool through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, the zones to be separated by retrievable type packers.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.
- (5) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Leonard Oil Company, is hereby authorized to complete its Ginsberg-Federal Well No. 11 as a triple completion (conventional) in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Justis Blinebry Pool through a string of 2 1/16-inch tubing and from an undesignated Tubb pool and the Justis Fusselman Pool through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, the zones to be separated by retrievable type packers.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with Rule 112-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

PROVIDED FURTHER HOWEVER, That the applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Fusselman zone, or at such other time as the Secretary-Director of the Commission may prescribe.


(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.


