ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 13, 1966, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 18th day of April, 1966, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new gas pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation of South Crossroads-San Andres Gas Pool. Said South Crossroads-San Andres Gas Pool was discovered by W. K. Byrom, T. P. State No. 1, located in Unit K of Section 10, Township 10 South, Range 36 East, NMPM. It was completed in San Andres on October 19, 1965. The top of perforations is 4904 feet.

(3) That there is need for the deletion of certain acreage from the Red Lake Pool and the extension of the Artesia Pool to include said acreage in order that all wells in the same lease will be in one pool. Both pools are in Eddy County, New Mexico.

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Linda-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, in Eddy County, New Mexico, the Chaveroo-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, the South Corbin-Queen Pool, the Jenkins-Cisco Pool, the Justis-Blinebry Pool, the Morton-

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Lower Wolfcamp Pool, the Querecho Plains-Pennsylvanian Pool, and the Scarborough Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for San Andres production, is hereby created and designated as the South Crossroads-San Andres Gas Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 10: SW/4

(b) That the Chaveroo-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 19: SW/4
SECTION 20: SE/4
SECTION 24: SW/4 and N/2
SECTION 25: W/2
SECTION 26: S/2 and NW/4
SECTION 28: NE/4
SECTION 30: NE/4
SECTION 32: SW/4
SECTION 35: NW/4 and E/2

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 19: NW/4

(c) That the South Corbin-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 34: N/2

(d) That the Jenkins-Cisco Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 25: NW/4

(e) That the Justis-Blinebry Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 26: SW/4 and S/2 NW/4

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(f) That the Morton-Lower Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 12: SE/4

(g) That the Querecho Plains-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 15: SW/4
SECTION 22: NW/4

(h) That the Scarborough Yates-Seven Rivers Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 30: SW/4

(i) That the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 29: All
SECTION 32: All

(j) That the Red Lake Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby contracted by the deletion of the following-described area:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 31: SE/4 NE/4 and E/2 SE/4

(k) That the Artesia Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 31: SE/4 NE/4 and E/2 SE/4

(l) That the Linda-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 8: N/2 NE/4

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
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:
