It appearing to the Commission that Order No. R-1670-X
and R-333-F-2-B, dated December 2, 1983, does not correctly
state the intended order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Order No. (3) on page 6 of Order No. R-1670-X
and R-333-F-2-B is hereby amended to read in its entirety as
follows:

"(3) That effective April 1, 1984, Rule (11) of
said General Rules is hereby amended to read in its
entirety as follows:


'RULE 11. A minimum allowable of 250 MCF per
month per proration unit will be assigned in order to
prevent the premature abandonment of wells.'


(2) That the corrections set forth in this order be entered
