ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 17, 1954, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 15th day of April, 1954, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and exhibits received at said hearing,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That creation of a new oil pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico, advertised as the 'Medio-Entrada Pool', should be deferred pending readvertisement for correction of both name and description.

(3) That the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool should be extended as advertised.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 27 North, Range 4 West  
Sections 14 through 23, all;  
Sections 29 through 32, all

Township 27 North, Range 5 West  
Sections 13 and 14, all;  
Sections 23 through 26, all;  
Sections 35 and 36, all

Township 30 North, Range 11 West  
Sections 23, 26, 35 and 36, all

(b) That the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 29 North, Range 13 West  
S/2 Section 28; all Section 33

Township 28 North, Range 13 West  
E/2 of Partial Section 10
