ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on August 9, 1973, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Elvis A. Utz.

NOW, on this 23rd day of August, 1973, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That Kent Shannon is the owner and operator of the Chaparral Tejano Well No. 1, located in Unit D of Section 10, Township 7 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

(3) That said well was drilled in 1968 and was not productive of commercial quantities of oil or gas.

(4) That notice of intention to plug and abandon said well was filed with the Commission on March 6, 1970.

(5) That said well has not been plugged and the operator has not corresponded with the Commission since 1970.

(6) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said Chaparral Tejano Well No. 1 should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by the Artesia District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on or before October 1, 1973.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That Kent Shannon and American Employers' Insurance Company are hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Chaparral Tejano Well No. 1, located in Unit D of Section 10, Township 7 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico, on or before October 1, 1973.


(2) That Kent Shannon and American Employers' Insurance Company, prior to plugging and abandoning the above-described well, shall obtain from the Artesia Office of the Commission, a Commission-approved program for said plugging and abandoning, and shall notify said Artesia Office of the date and hour said work is to be commenced whereupon the Commission may, at its option, witness such work.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
