It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-6796, dated October 13, 1981, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That Order No. (1) on page 2 of Order No. R-6796 be and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) That the applicant, Doyle Hartman, is hereby authorized to directionally drill his Bates Well No. 3, the surface location of which is 1635 feet from the South line and 1210 feet from the West line of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, in such a manner as to bottom it at a depth of 3500 feet in the Jalmat Gas Pool at an unorthodox location within 100 feet of a point 2310 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 20."

(2) That the corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of October 13, 1981.
