ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m. on December 14, 1955, and at 9 o'clock a. m. on January 19, 1956, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, herein-after referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 26th day of February, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented, and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the deletion of a certain area from the boundaries of Bagley Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(e) That the Bagley Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby contracted by the deletion of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM
Section 33: SE/4
