ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause was reopened and heard at 9 a.m. on September 12, 1984, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 30th day of October, 1984, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) Case No. 8111 was originally heard before the Commission on July 17, 1984, and, pursuant to that hearing, Order No. R-7631 was issued on August 23, 1984.

(3) At the request of the New Mexico Public Service Commission, this Case is being reopened at this time for additional testimony.

(4) The evidence adduced at said hearing indicates that Division Order No. R-7631 entered August 23, 1984, should be affirmed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Division Order No. R-7631, entered August 23, 1984, is hereby affirmed.




(2) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
