CHAVES AND LEA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on January 6, 1988, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 11th day of January, 1988, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Drinkard formation, said pool to bear the designation of East Nadine-Drinkard Pool. Said East Nadine-Drinkard Pool was discovered by the Crown Central Petroleum Corporation Emerald Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Drinkard formation on November 25, 1987. The top of the perforations is at 7,041 feet.

(3) There is need for certain extensions to the West Caprock-Morrow Gas Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, and the Antelope Ridge-Atoka Gas Pool, the Antelope Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool, the Arkansas Junction-Queen Gas Pool, the Central Corbin-Queen Pool, the Gladiola-Wolfcamp Pool, the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, the Kemnitz-Lower Wolfcamp Pool, the Northeast Lovington-Pennsylvanian Pool, the East Lusk-Bone

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Spring Pool, the West Lusk-Delaware Pool, the Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, the South Shoe Bar-Devonian Pool, the South Shoe Bar-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, the East Shugart-Delaware Pool, and the Townsend Permo-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(a) A new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Drinkard production is hereby created and designated as the East Nadine-Drinkard Pool, consisting of the following described area:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Section 70-2-18, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of

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
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this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well, or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

(2) The effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be February 1, 1988.
