ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN  
POOLS IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-9544 dated July 1, 1991, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. (2) on page 1 of said Division Order No. R-9544 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(2) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of North Baum-Wolfcamp Pool. Said North Baum-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by the Petroleum Production Management, Inc. State 19 Well No. 1 located in Unit I of Section 19, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Wolfcamp formation on September 8, 1990. The top of the perforations is at 9,369 feet."

(2) Decretory Paragraph (a) on page 3 of said Order No. R-9544 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) A new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Wolfcamp production is hereby created and designated as the North Baum-Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM  
Section 19: SE/4"


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(3) The corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of July 1, 1991.
