FINDS THAT:


- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Union Oil Company of California d/b/a UNOCAL, seeks an order promulgating special rules for the Red Hills-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, including a provision for 640-acre spacing units and designated well location requirements. Said pool comprises Sections 31, 32 and 33, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, and Sections 4, 5 and 6, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, all in Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) The applicant has requested that this case be dismissed.
- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.

Case No. 10457 is hereby dismissed.
