Cause of Release: On May 14, 2021 at approximately 9:45 a.m., Enterprise had a release of condensate from an above ground storage tank at Lindrith Compressor Station. Approximately 80 barrels of condensate was released into a lined secondary containment. No liquids were observed outside of the secondary containment. No residences were affected. No emergency services responded. The tank was drained and removed from service. The condensate was removed from the secondary containment via a spec truck. The liner will be steam cleaned. An inspection of the liner will be scheduled with NMOCD and Jicarilla Apache Environmental Protection Office. A final C-141 will be submitted upon completion of liner inspection.


