Cause of Release: On December 29, 2021, Enterprise had fire at the A-4 straddle compressor. The fire was caused by a catalytic heater igniting a tarp. The tarp was used for wind protection. A third-party producer extinguished the fire utilizing fire extinguishers. No natural gas nor natural gas liquids were released. No washes or residents were affected. No emergency services responded.


