DCP has a back pressure valve installed on their sales meter run that closes and diverts our gas to flare when their pressure increases above a set amount.
Steps taken to limit the duration and magnitude of vent or flare	We contacted DCP and notified them of our high line pressure.
Corrective actions taken to eliminate the cause and reoccurrence of vent or flare	DCP needs to install more compression so back up compression is available.
