Pima Environmental Services LLC. (Pima) has been contracted by Devon Energy Production Company, LP (Devon) to prepare this Remediation Closure Report for a produced water release that occurred at the Cotton Draw 13 Federal #1H (Cotton). This incident was assigned Incident ID nAPP2110326244 by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD). The Initial Form C-141 can be found in Appendix C.

RELEASE INFORMATION

<u>nAPP2110326244:</u> On March 8, 2021, the, within the containment, water tank ran over. There was a breech in the containment which resulted in impact to the pad. Please see the attached calculations. Approximately 435 barrels (bbls) were released, approximately 420 bbls were recovered via vacuum truck.

SITE CHARACTERIZATION

The Cotton is located approximately twenty (20) miles southeast of Malaga, NM. This release area is in Unit M, Section 13, Township 25S, Range 31E, Latitude 32.1239395, Longitude -103.7380219, Eddy County, NM. Figure 1 references a Location Map.

Per the New Mexico Bureau of Geology and Mineral Resources, the geology is Eolian and piedmont deposits. Interlayered eolian sands and piedmont-slope deposits along the eastern flank of the Pecos River valley, primarily between Roswell and Carlsbad. Typically capped by thin eolian deposits. The soil in this area is made up of Berino complex, 0 to 3 percent slopes, eroded according to the United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service soil survey (Appendix B). The drainage class is well-drained. There is a low potential for karst geology to be present around the Cotton (Figure 3) with the nearest medium karst zone being 1.44 miles to the southwest. Reference Figure 2 for a Topographic Map.

According to the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer, depth to the nearest groundwater in this area is greater than 55 feet below grade surface (bgs). This information is provided by C-04925-POD1 which is located approximately 0.45 miles west of the release area and was drilled on February 6, 2025. According to the United States Geological Survey, USGS 320932103443801 25S.31E.2.23441 puts the nearest groundwater at 390 feet bgs, with the last gauge being conducted in 1976. This well resides approximately 2.41 miles north of the Cotton release area. The closest surface water body is Red Bluff Reservoir located approximately 15.3 miles to the southwest of this location. See Appendix A for referenced Water Surveys and Water-Related Maps.

According to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetlands Inventory, a Freshwater Emergent Wetland lies approximately 1.91 miles to the northwest of the Cotton release area. According to a FEMA search for flood hazard information, the Cotton is in Zone X – Area of Minimal Flood Hazard.

Closure criteria for releases at the Cotton pad surface are classified under the 51-100-foot depth to groundwater section of Table 1 19.15.29.12 NMAC. The regulatory limits are as follows: Chlorides should be less than 10,000 mg/kg, TPH (GRO+DRO+MRO) should be less than 2,500 mg/kg, GRO+DRO should be less than 1,000 mg/kg, BTEX

should be less than 50 mg/kg, and Benzene should be less than 10 mg/kg.

SITE ASSESSMENT ACTIVITIES

On May 10, 2023, Pima personnel mobilized to the release site to perform an assessment of the affected area. Discrete soil samples were collected using a hand auger from three (3) different sample points within the release area. These samples were collected from depths of 1', 2', and 3' bgs. Discrete samples were collected from four (4) different sample points around the edges of the release area. These samples were collected from a depth of 6" bgs. One (10) discrete sample was collected from the pasture, just off the pad as a background sample. This sample was collected from a depth of 6" bgs. A total of fourteen (14) samples were collected, put on ice, prepared for delivery, then delivered to Envirotech Analytical Laboratory for official analysis of all constituents listed in Table 1 19.15.29.12 NMAC. An Original Site Map can be found in Figure 4.

On May 14, 2023, after a 48-hour notification of a liner inspection was submitted via email, Pima personnel mobilized to the site to perform the inspection. It was found that the deficiencies mentioned in the initial C141, in the containment wall at the southeast corner of the secondary containment, were still not properly repaired.

On May 19, 2023, the analytical report was received and verified vertical and horizontal delineation for all sample points. All sample results can be referenced in the Data Tables in Figure 5.

On January 5, 2024, after Devon submitted a 48-hour notification for a liner inspection, Pima personnel mobilized to the site to perform the final inspection. The deficiencies in the containment wall had been patched, the containment had been power washed, and the rest of the liner was inspected for tears, holes, and damage. None were found. It was concluded that this secondary containment liner now had the integrity to maintain a release. Photographic Documentation along with the Liner Inspection Form can be found in Appendix D.

On March 11, 2024, Pima personnel returned to the release site to reassess and correctly complete vertical and horizontal delineation of the release area. Using a hand auger, discrete samples were collected from four (4) new sample points withing the release area. These samples were collected from depths of 1', 2', 3', and 4' bgs. Subsamples were collected from seven (7) new sample points around the edges of the release area for horizontal delineation. These subsamples were collected at 1' increments from each sample point to 4' bgs then combined to create composite samples. One sample was again collected, as a background sample, from the pasture just off the pad from a depth of 1' bgs. A total of twenty-four (24) samples were put on ice, prepared for delivery, then delivered to Envirotech Analytical Laboratories for official analysis of all constituents listed in Table 1. A New Site Map can be found in Figure 6.

On March 19, 2024, the analytical report was received and verified that vertical and horizontal delineation had been achieved for all sample points except S1 and S2.

On June 3, 2024, Pima personnel returned to the site to complete vertical delineation of sample points S1 and S2. Using a hand auger, each sample point was advanced to a depth of 5' bgs. The samples were collected, put on ice, prepared for delivery, then delivered to Cardinal Laboratories for official analysis of all constituents listed in Table 1.

On June 13, 2024, the analytical report was received and verified that vertical delineation of samples points S1 and S2 had been achieved. All sample results can be found in the Data Tables in Figure 5. Complete Laboratory Reports can be found in Appendix E.

REMEDIATION ACTIVITIES

On February 6, 2025, Devon contracted H&R Enterprises to install a borehole within ½-mile of the Cotton to obtain new groundwater data. A borehole was installed at 32 degrees, 7 minutes, 14.1 seconds N latitude, and -103 degrees, 44 minutes, 45.7 seconds W longitude in section 23, township 25S, range 31E in Eddy County, New Mexico. The borehole was drilled with a truck-mounted air rotary drill to a depth of 55 feet bgs. A temporary well casing was installed, and the borehole was left open for no less than 72 hours. Photographic Documentation can be found in Appendix D.

On February 10, 2025, a technician returned to the borehole site to gauge the bore for the presence of water. The

gauging event verified the hole to be dry, no water or water bearing soil was encountered. The hole was then plugged according to the approved-plugging plan, and the surface was restored to its previous state.

CLOSURE REQUEST

Based on the laboratory results, and the installation of C-04925-POD1, the contamination levels represented in all sample points are under the regulatory limits according to the closure criteria outlined in the 51-100-foot depth to groundwater section of Table 1 19.15.29.12 NMAC. The release area has been successfully delineated vertically and horizontally. Devon requests that this incident, nAPP2110326244, be closed. Devon is also aware of and understands that reclamation of this pad area once it is no longer needed for production or subsequent drilling operations will require an approved reclamation plan report addressing a minimum of four feet of non-waste containing earthen material. Followed by a revegetation plan report once the site has reached the required vegetative status.
