Please explain reason for why this event was beyond this operator's control	An internal flyover detected an emission event at the facility. Chevron was notified of the event on 6/11/2025. Upon notification, LDAR was dispatched to the facility to investigate. Upon investigation it was determined that the compressor blowdown line had a leaking valve.
Steps taken to limit the duration and magnitude of vent or flare	Upon discovery of the leaking valve, operations shut down the facility and dispatched mechanics to the facility to make necessary repairs.
Corrective actions taken to eliminate the cause and reoccurrence of vent or flare	The facility was shut in to end the event and the failed valve was repaired to prevent future occurrences. This facility has been prioritized for the installation of emission event detection equipment installation.
