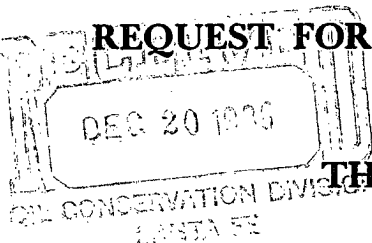

* This sand is a sand bar at the base of the Niobrara section. It is equivalent to the Tocito, Bisti, or Cha Cha type of basal Niobrara sands in the San Juan Basin. However, it is a distinct and separate sand body and in the Santa Fe area, Black Oil, Inc. calls this new sand bar the Gurley Sand to distinguish it from the other basal Niobrara sands in the separate and distant San Juan Basin.
