I understand that I can check my compliance with the single-well financial assurance requirement by usultantive Well Additional Financial Assurance Report" on the OCD's website.
- 6. I am responsible for reporting releases as defined by 19.15.29 NMAC. I understand the OCD will look to me as the operator take corrective action for releases at my wells and related facilities, including releases that occurred before I became operat
- 7. I have read 19.15.5.9 NMAC, commonly known as "Part 5.9," and understand that to be in compliance with its reduirements the appropriate financial assurances in place, comply with orders requiring corrective action, pay penalties assessed by the agreed to by me in a settlement agreement, and not have too many wells out of compliance with the inactive well rule (19.15 NMAC). If I am in violation of Part 5.9, I may not be allowed to drill, acquire or produce any additional wells, and will not be any new injection permits.
