Plugging Report

10/12/2020 Move in rig and plugging equipment. Clear location. Dig out cellar to the surface head and plumb to the steel pit. Install BOP and start OOH with the tubing. Tubing was bad. Start laying down tubing. Laid down 20 joints and SION.

10/13/2020 Finish laying down tubing that was in the wellbore. Attempted gauge ring run and could not get past 2350'. POOH with wireline. Picked up 4 ½" scraper and RIH with workstring to 3648' without issue. POOH with scraper and set 4 ½" CIBP on tubing at 3606'. SION

10/14/2020 Circulated MLF and tested casing to 500#. Casing good. Spot 25 sx Class C cement on top of CIBP with CaCl. WOC and tagged at 3239'. POOH and perforated casing at 1992'. Set packer and pressured up on perfs to 600# and held. Could not establish injection rate. POOH with packer. RIH with tubing to 2061' and spot 25 sx cement across the perfs. POOH and SION.

10/15/2020 Tagged cement at 1706'. Perforated casing at 1393'. Set packer and worked perfs until circulation was gained. Good communication with surface. Squeezed perfs with 50 sx cement with CaCl. WOC and tag at 1131'. Laid down remaining tubing and perforated casing at 200'. Pumped cement down the 4 ½" casing to the perfs at 200' and up the annulus to surface. Took 55 sx to get good cement to surface. SION

10/16/2020 Rigged down. Dug out wellhead and cut off. Filled up 4 ½" with 1 sack of cement. 8 5/8" was full. Installed BGM, cleaned the pit, and removed the anchors.
