\_\_\_ M.I.T. for Temporary Abandonment, shall include a detailed description on **Form C-103**, including the location of the CIBP and any other tubular goods in the well including the Operator's request for TA status timeline.

Therefore, Operator has within a 30-day period from the M.I.T. to submit a current C-103 along with a legible scan of the Chart, including a detailed description of the repair(s). **Only after receipt of the C-103 will the non-compliance be closed.**

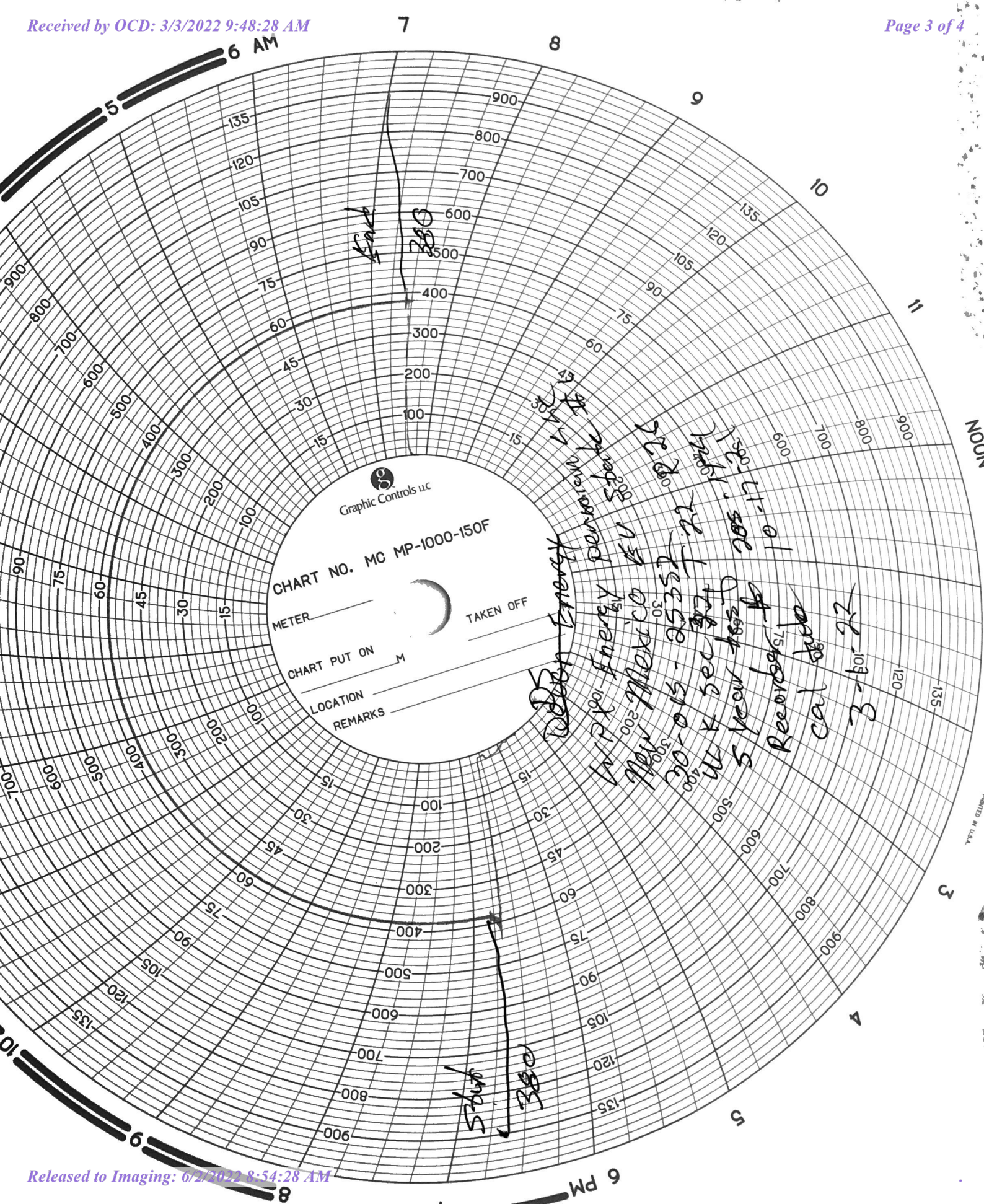
