8. Spot 25 sxs Class C cement on CIBP, wait on cement.

10. Perf @ 3,975'. Unable to pump into perforations. Notify BLM.
11. Spot 25 sxs Class C cement at 4,025', wait on cement.
12. Tag cement @ 3,633'.
13. Perf @ 2,735'. Unable to pump into perforations. Notify BLM.
14. Spot 25 sxs Class C cement at 2,782', wait on cement.
15. Tag cement @ 2,397'.
16. Perf @ 2,349'. Unable to pump into perforations. Notify BLM.
17. Spot 25 sxs Class C cement at 2,371', wait on cement.
18. Tag cement @ 1,982'.
19. Perf @ 409'. Unable to pump into perforations. Notify BLM.
20. Pump 80 sxs Class C cement at 460', filling casing to surface.
21. Dig Out X Cut Off Wellhead 3' B.G.L.; Verify cement to surface on all annuli; Weld on Steel Plate to casing. Install Below Ground Level Dry Hole Marker.
