Procedure Description: AMEND SUNDRY 2755517 approved 1-10-2024: correct well name tied back to sundry & operating pressure of monoline. XTO Permian Operating, LLC. respectfully requests approval to construct a temporary frac monoline of approximately 7-1/16" diameter. The maximum operating pressure of the monoline will be 12,500 psi. The line will transport sand and frac fluid from one pad to another during frac operations. A separate pump down line approximately 3" in diameter will be laid beside the monoline. This line will transport sand, frac fluid and/or pump down fluid during frac operations. The maximum pressure for the pump down line will be 12,500 psi. The lines will sit atop support structures. The lines will be laid via a boom truck, backhoe, crane and/or a similar piece of machinery. There will be no digging or trenching. The monoline will be laid before frac operations begin and will be removed after frac operations cease. Both lines will travel from the east side of the PLU 16 TWR Pad B/C to the west side of the PLU 16 TWR Pad D (approximately 496.61 feet).


