Actual Procedure: 7/8/25. Rig 9, traveled out to location, had JSA/Safety meeting. Waited on API wireline tell 9:00am. spotted in truck, rigged wireline. Made gauge ring run to 3900. Set CIBP 3830. Loaded and test to 500psi, held pressure for 15mins. Test was good. open well. Ran W/L CBL. Rigged down W/L, TIH open ended with 122jts of 2-7/8 j55 eue tbg tagged CIBP. Pulled up one jt, shut well in and shut down for the day. 7/9/25. Crew traveled out to location, Waited on CBL to be reviewed. Rolled the hole with 80 bbls of #9.5 mud. Worked on batching 25sx of cement, had equipment issues, and could not pump cement plug. Discarded cement into trash tank. Due to equipment issues, a third-party company has been scheduled to help complete the job 7/10/25. Cleaned equipment and location and shut down for the day. Resume operations 07/10/2025 @ 7:00 a.m. 7/10/25. Crew traveled out to location, Had JSA/Safety meeting. Waited on vac trucks, spotted in Nine Energy Service. Spot 25 sacks class C cement @ 3830, displaced with 18.5bbls. Laid down 8jts, pulled 10 stands. Waited 4hrs, TBIH to tag. Tagged at 3780. Spotted 25 sacks class C cement @3780. Displaced 18.5bbls, waited 4hrs. tagged with tbg at 3550. Laid down a total of 34 joints. Spotted 122 sacks class C cement@ 2812. Displaced 8bbls. Laid down 38jts, pulled 5 stands. Shut well in and shut down for the day. Resume operation 7/11/25 @ 7:00 a.m. 7/11/25. Crew traveled out to location, had a JSA/Safety meeting. TIH and tag @ 1800. Spotted 30 sacks class C cement@ 1800. Displaced 8.5 bbls. Laid down 10jts, pulled 5 stands. Waited 4hrs. TBIH to tag, Tagged @ 1466. Laid down 5jts. Spotted 135 sacks class C cement @ 1350. Viewed cement circulating out of the casing. TOH laying down 42jts. Rigged down Nine Energy Service. Rigged down tbg equipment and working floor. Secured well and shut down for the day. 7/12/25. Crew traveled out to location. had JSA/Safety meeting. Spotted 11 sacks class C cement to surface. ND BOP, rigged down pulling unit. Cleaned and moved equipment off location.


