Per the Division's Hobbs District office, the Bureau researched the records for this well and found no individual Injection Pressure Increase (IPI) order and corresponding application (SRT and interpretation). However, the original file folder, which contained the well documentation prior to the transfer of the online database, shows a handwritten note showing a pressure increase to 1320 psig on June 26, 1992 (see below).

This note on the IPI corresponds to a period in Division's history when the IPI orders were reported in a quarterly summary and not assigned individual order numbers as currently done. These documents are not available for review (archived) and, therefore, the approved pressure for this well is 1320 psig until a change in well parameters (tubing diameter) or issues with the approved injection pressure requires a new evaluation.
