As operator of the Nash Unit, and in compliance with the terms of the Nash Unit Agreement dated June 1, 1974, XTO Holdings LLC (XTO) hereby submits for SLO review this letter with the attached Exhibit "A" as a Supplement to its previously submitted 2018 Plan of Development (POD).
