Then POOH w/ WS to 1351'. Spot 30 sx Class C cmt plug w/2% CaCl from 1351' to 1240'. POOH w/ WS to 500' & WOC. RIH w/ WS & tag cmt plug @ 1250'. POOH w/ WS to 63' & spot 10 sx Class C cmt w/ 2% CaCl from 63' to surface. LD WS & fill hole w/cmt. SD & WOC. Release Service Unit and begin filling pit and restoring location. Set Dry Hole Marker after cutting off surface pipe below GL. Fill cellar and finish surface restoration. Planting native grasses and bringing location back to original surface contours. Well is P&A'd as of 9/23/2008.

Previous lease owner wishes to keep roadways and other improvements to location as they will be taking new leases and re-drilling this well shortly.
