Gentlemen,

By copy of this letter, Doyle Hartman hereby makes application for the approval of a new 240-acre, non-standard Jalmat proration unit consisting of the N/2 NW/4 and NE/4 Section 32, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Arnett Ramsay NCT-B No. 3 Jalmat Gas well is the only active producer situated on the proposed non-standard Jalmat proration unit. Portions of the new 240-acre, non-standard Jalmat proration unit were part of the 400-acre, non-standard Jalmat proration unit comprising the NE/4, NE/4 NW/4, E/2 SW/4, N/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4 Section 32, T-25-S, R-37-E. The 400-acre, non-standard Jalmat proration unit was approved by Administrative Order NSP-1628-B (SD), dated July 23, 1993 (copy enclosed). The formation of the requested 240-acre, non-standard Jalmat proration unit is necessary because the active Jalmat producers which are located in the S/2 NW/4 and S/2 of said Section 32 are Jalmat Oil wells.

Dear Mr. Mashburn:

By Division Administrative Order NSP-1628(L)(SD), dated June 20, 1991, as corrected July 9, 1991, Doyle Hartman, Oil Operator, was authorized a 480-acre nonstandard gas spacing and proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the E/2 and E/2 W/2 of Section 32, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in which was dedicated the Arnott Ramsay (NCT-B) Well Nos. 7 and 13, both located at standard gas well locations in Units I and O, respectively, and the Arnott Ramsay (NCT-B) Well No. 10 located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) all in said Section 32.

By Division Administrative Order NSP-1628-A(SD), dated September 19, 1991, 40 acres, comprising the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) were withdrawn from the subject 480-acre gas spacing and proration unit to accommodate the removal of the Arnott-Ramsay (NCT-B) Well No. 10 because of its redesignation from a gas well to an oil well within the Jalmat Oil and Gas Pool.

Reference is now made to your application dated June 16, 1993 to reduce said 440-acre unit by deleting the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of said Section 32 and to remove the Arnott Ramsay (NCT-B) Well No. 13 from the gas proration unit altogether.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170 as amended, a 400-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in said pool comprising the NE/4, NE/4 NW/4, E/2 SW/4, N/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 32 is hereby approved.






