**Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas 71629)**

Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM  
Section 5: E/2

Currently these areas contain or will soon contain the following wells.

West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool

**Schwerdtfeger "5" Well No. 1** (API No. 30-045-27819) Lease #NMSF080382A  
Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool

This permit shall be amended if additional pool(s) are to be added within these areas as described above or these areas as described above are to be extended.

It is our understanding that ownership is not identical. Gas production shall be allocated by separately and continuously metering the gas production from each well or group of wells with identical ownership within this gathering system. Liquid production shall not be commingled.

The sales point for gas production shall be near the well site of the Schwerdtfeger "5" Well No. 1 in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 5.
