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

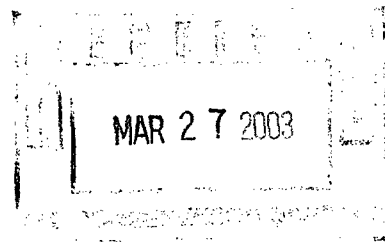

Dear Mr. Stogner:

Pursuant to Rule 104.F(2), Arch Petroleum Inc. ("Arch") applies for two unorthodox oil well locations, for the following wells:

<u>Well:</u>	C.E. Lamunyon Well No. 84
<u>Location:</u>	545 feet FNL & 1169 feet FEL
<u>Well Unit:</u>	NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ S28

<u>Well:</u>	C.E. Lamunyon Well No. 85
<u>Location:</u>	2310 feet FNL & 2630 feet FWL
<u>Well Unit:</u>	SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ S28

Both wells are in located in Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The wells will be drilled to test the Teague Paddock-Blinebry Pool, which is an oil pool developed on statewide spacing. APD's for the wells are attached as Exhibits A and B.

Attached as Exhibit C is a structure/production map of the Teague Paddock-Blinebry Pool, with the locations of the two proposed wells noted thereon. The two locations are located at structurally good locations, and are situated between existing wells in the anticipation that they will recover reserves not produced by the existing wells.

Exhibit D outlines the C.E. Lamunyon lease (Federal Lease LC 030187), which covers (among other acreage) the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28. Because the locations are interior to the lease, and interest ownership in the lease is common, no one is affected by the

unorthodox locations. Therefore, notice of the locations has not been given to anyone.
