Gentlemen:

Shell Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval to change the limiting ratio of Downhole Commingling Order No. 68 dated September 29, 1970 from 2000 to 6000 for Shell Livingston Well No. 10, located in Lot 10 of Section 4, Township 21-S, Range 37-E NMPM, Lea County. This will allow the maximum amount of gas which may be produced from the Drinkard pool to be determined by multiplying 6000 by the top unit allowable rather than 2000 as stipulated in Downhole Commingling Order No. 68.
