

BP America Production Company respectfully requests an amendment to Administrative Order NSL-831-A to include administrative approval for a non-standard well location for the Pritchard Well No. 4A to be recompleted into the Otero Chacra Pool. The subject well was drilled by Tenneco Oil Company in 1977 at a non-standard well location for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool: Administrative Order NSL – 831, dated March 28, 1977 and approved for recompletion at a non-standard location in the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool per above order effective November 17, 2004.

It is our intent to complete the well into both the Blanco Pictured Cliffs and Otero Chacra Pools and downhole commingle production with the existing Mesaverde Pool. Application for permission to downhole commingle production is being submitted to the Santa Fe Office.

The spacing unit for this well is the NW/4 Section 31 as shown on attached C-102. Also attached is a 9 section plats with the subject well and surrounding wells and operators identified.

BP has a 50% working interest & ConocoPhillips and has 50% working interest in the NW/4 of section 31 and BP has a 100% working interest in the offsetting tract (NE/4 of Section 31).

Dear Ms. Corley:

Reference is made to the following: (a) your application (***administrative application reference No. pSEM0-430933628***) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on November 3, 2004; and (b) the Division's records in Santa Fe and Aztec, including the files on: (i) Division Orders No. R-46, R-60, R-1169, R1170, R-1390, and R-4002; (ii) Division Administrative Orders NSL-831 and DHC-1689-AZ; and (iii) the well records for BP America Production Company's ("BP") Pritchard Well No. 4 (**API No. 30-045-07643**): all concerning BP's request for an unorthodox gas well location in the Pictured Cliffs formation for the existing Pritchard Well No. 4-A (**API No. 30-045-22497**), located 1830 feet from the North line and 1705 feet from the West line (Lot 8/Unit F) of Irregular Section 31, Township 29 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 5, 6, 7, and 8 (NW/4 equivalent) of Irregular Section 31 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a 120.49-acre gas spacing unit within the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool (**72359**).

This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F, revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999.

By Division Administrative Order NSL-831, dated March 28, 1977, Tenneco Oil Company received authorization to drill to and complete the above-described Pritchard Well No. 4-A in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool (**72319**) at an unorthodox infill gas well location within a non-standard 375.09-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit comprising Lots 3 and 4 and the E/2 SW/4 (SW/4 equivalent) of Section 30 and Lots 5 through 12 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 31, which unit was the subject of Division Orders No. R-60, issued in Case No. 258 on March 21, 1951, and R-1390, issued in Case No. 1642 on May 7, 1959. According to Division records, BP became the operator of this well on December 31, 2001.


It is the Division's understanding that BP now intends to perforate the Pictured Cliffs interval and recomplete the well such that gas production from both the Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs formations will be downhole commingled (as referenced by Division Administrative Order DHC-1689-AZ issued by the Aztec district office of the Division on November 5, 2004).

The location of this well within the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool is also considered to be unorthodox pursuant to Division Rule 104.C (3), as revised.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F (2), as revised, the above-described unorthodox Pictured Cliffs gas well location for BP's Pritchard Well No. 4-A within the proposed 120.49-acre gas spacing unit comprising the NW/4 equivalent of Section 31 is hereby approved.

Further, the provisions of Division Order NSL-831 shall remain in full force and affect until further notice.
