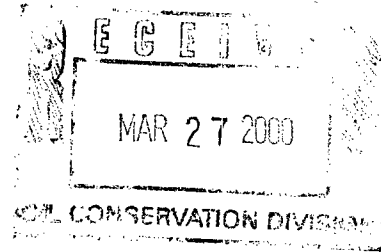

Dear Mr. Stogner:

Nassau Resources, Inc. hereby requests administrative approval for an unorthodox location for the captioned well based upon topographic conditions and Carson National Forest Requirements.

As indicated on the attached topographic map, the terrain in the standard location is extremely rough. The Carson National Forest, as indicated on the attached letter, requires the well to be drilled at the proposed location to prevent disturbing new surface area. The proposed location is on the site of a well that has been plugged and abandoned and the surface is already disturbed.

Nassau Resources, Inc. is the operator of this and all offsetting leases. Working Interest Owners of offsetting leases are BP Amoco and McHugh Companies. Nassau Resources is the operating affiliate for McHugh Companies and as such, notification of McHugh is an internal matter. 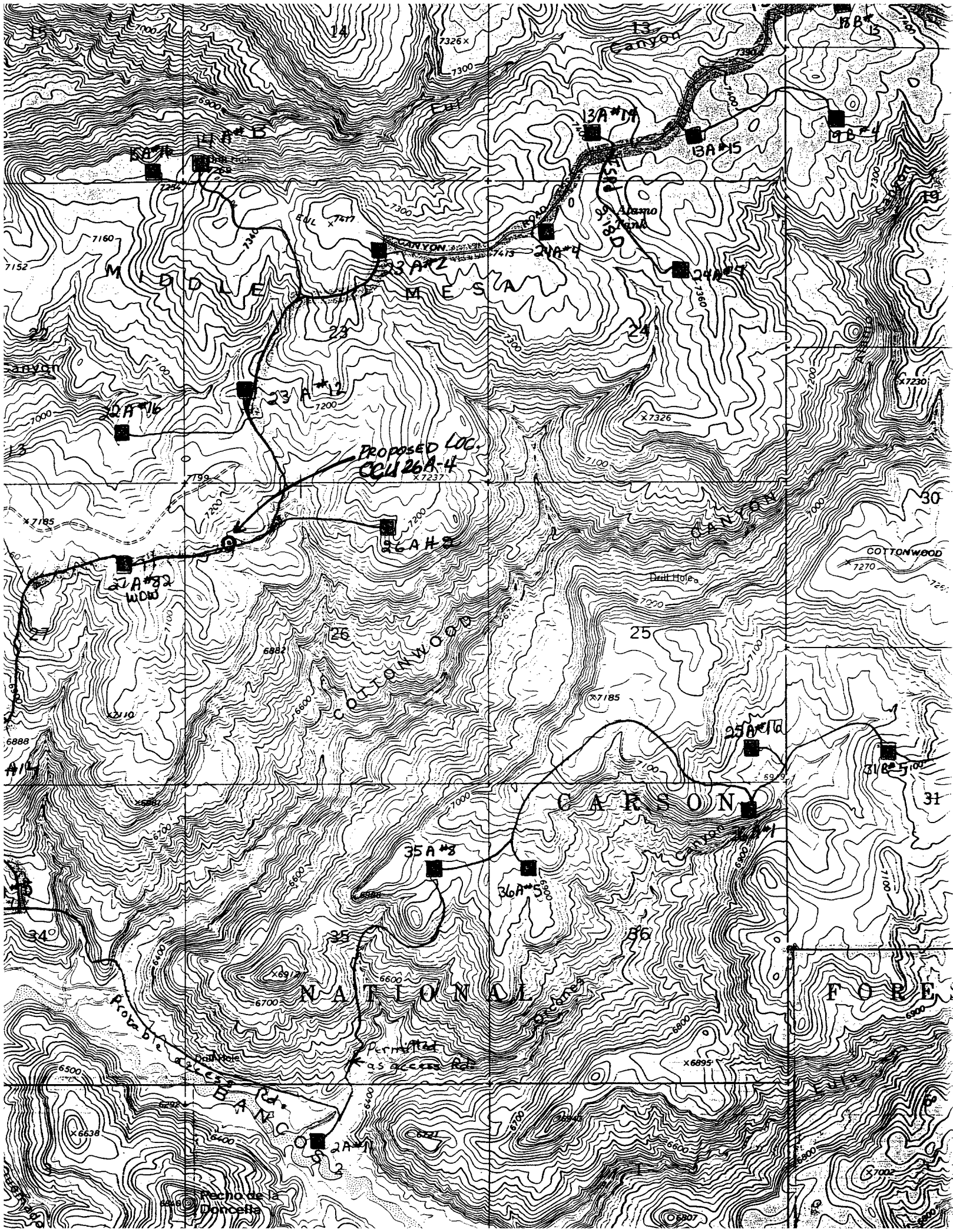

The Jicarilla Ranger District, Carson National Forest is requesting you apply for an unorthodox location as follows, as discussed by your company representative and Camela Hooley of this office:

Well name, T32N R5W Sec.26, 1003'FNL/778'FWL

The mineral operator is required to comply with other applicable regulations such as the Endangered Species Act and the Archeological Resources Protection Act under 36CFR228.112(c). The operator is also required under 36CFR228.108(c) to minimize or prevent damage to surface resources. The Carson National Forest Management Plan states that surface resource impacts will be minimized when administering mineral resources.

The following conditions apply which require an unorthodox location:

☐ Archeological resources prevent locating the well in an orthodox location.

☒ Topography prevents locating the well in an orthodox location. The entire SW quarter section is very steep with no roads.

☐ Threatened/endangered species concerns prevent locating the well in an orthodox location.

☒ Prevention of unnecessary resource damage requires the location be unorthodox. (Such as a previously disturbed area or existing road available outside the drilling window.)
