

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Conoco's letter of October 17, 2000 to the NMOCD requesting a 120-acre Jalmat proration unit for the Jack "B-30" No. 2 well located in NW/4NE/4 Section 30, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. By *Assignment and Bill of Sale*, effective November 1, 1999 (partial copy enclosed), Doyle Hartman and James A. Davidson acquired all right, title and interest of Conoco, et al, as to the Jalmat interval, corresponding to the E/2NE/4, SW/4NE/4 Section 30, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, being 120 acres.

Reference is also made to Conoco's letter dated November 4, 1999 (copy enclosed), wherein Conoco outlined to Chevron USA Production Company and Apache Corporation, the terms of the NMFU's November 1, 1999 assignment to Hartman and Davidson, wherein Conoco, et al (as assignors to Hartman and Davidson) were to retain the 40 acres in the NW/4NE/4 Section 30, which was to be dedicated to the Jack "B-30" No. 2 oil well, with Doyle Hartman/James A. Davidson receiving the remaining 120 acres (E/2NE/4, SW/4NE/4 Section 30, T-24-S, R-37-E).

In this regard, please find enclosed copies of our prior filings, with the NMOCD, that document that the Jack "B-30" No. 1 well (H-30-24-37) and the newly drilled Jack "B-30" No. 3 well (A-30-24-37) are both Jalmat oil wells, with 40 acres assigned to each well. Moreover, please be advised that Doyle



Hartman and James A. Davidson are also evaluating the drilling of an additional Jalmat well on the 40 acres consisting of SW/4NE/4 Section 30, T-24-S, R-37-E, which 40 acre tract is owned by Doyle Hartman and James A. Davidson, by virtue of the November 1, 1999 assignment from Conoco, et al.

Therefore, in light of the foregoing, please be advised that Conoco's application to the NMOCD, in its present form, is inappropriate, and should be amended to include only 40 acres (NW/4NE/4 Section 30, T-24-S, R-37-E).



Gentlemen:

Conoco Inc. recently proposed the plugging and abandonment of the subject well. As I informed you over the telephone, Conoco, Chevron and Apache all approved the plugging and abandonment procedure. Mr. Doyle Hartman and Mr. James Davidson, however did not, but rather elected to exercise their right under the NMFU JOA to take over the well. Accordingly, the plugging parties and the parties electing to take over the well must settle any differences between plugging costs and salvage value of any equipment associated with the well. Conoco's AFE to plug the well was in the amount of \$9,720.00, the estimated salvage value of the equipment associated with the well is \$1,600.00. Therefore, each plugging party's share of plugging costs minus salvage value equals 25% WI X ($\$9,720 - \$1,600$) = \$2,030.00.

I've prepared appropriate county and BLM assignments to convey this well to Mr. Hartman and Mr. Davidson. Pursuant to the JOA, the depth is limited to the "intervals of the formations then open to production." The Jack B-30 No. 1 well is a Eumont gas well located in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 30, T24S-R37E. Spacing for these wells is 160 acres. The description for this assignment is limited to 120 acres because the Jack B-30 No. 2, a Eumont oil well on 40 acre spacing, is located in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 30. It was agreed that the plugging parties would keep the 40 acres surrounding this well. If there are any questions regarding how this was handled, please give me a call.

If everything meets with your approval, please have the attached assignments executed on behalf of your companies and return them to me at the above address along with your company's check in the amount of \$2,030.00 made out to Mr. Doyle Hartman. Mr. Hartman and Mr. Davidson have agreed to settle the cash difference on their own. I will forward the executed assignments and checks to Mr. Hartman and Mr. Davidson for final closing and will return fully executed originals to each of you. I have included sufficient signature pages for everyone to have a fully executed original for their files.


